## **Tables in Latex**

```
This code starts a table: \begin{tabular}{...}
```

Where the dots between the curly brackets are replaced by code de\_ning the columns:

- L for a column of left-aligned text (letter el, not number one).
- r for a column of right-aligned text.
- c for a column of centre-aligned text.
- | for a vertical line.

The table data follows the \begin command:

- & is placed between columns.
- \\ is placed at the end of a row (to start a new one)
- \hline inserts a horizontal line.

The command \end{tabular} finishes the table.

Apples & Green \\
Strawberries & Red \\
